ORDER:-

The Principal Secretary to Government, Industries and Commerce Department, Government of Telangana in his D.O. letter second read above has informed that the Government of India has issued further guidelines as part of Business Reform Action Plan-2019, for implementation of auto renewal system for registrations / licenses under certain Labour laws, in addition to the reforms already implemented.

2. In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad in his letter 3rd read above, Government after careful examination of the matter hereby decided to grant exemption from the applicability of sub-section (3) of section 9 of the Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1979 (Central Act 30 of 1979) and sub-rules (1) and (2) of Rule 14 of the Telangana Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1982 issued in G.O.Ms.No.677, Labour, Employment, Nutrition and Technical Education (Lab-II) Department, dated: 21.09.1982 in order to implement **Automatic non discretionary deemed renewal of license through online system**, without the requirement of filing of application for renewal, subject to payment of fee prescribed by the Government from time to time, within the time prescribed, until further orders.

3. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in the Extraordinary issue of the Telangana State Gazette, dated: 21.09.2020:

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 31 of the Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1979 (Central Act No.30 of 1979), the Government of Telangana hereby grant exemption from the applicability of sub-section (3) of section 9 of the said Act and sub-rules (1) and (2) of Rule 14 of the Telangana Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1982 issued in G.O.Ms.No.677, Labour, Employment, Nutrition and Technical Education (Lab-II) Department, dated: 21.09.1982, in order to implement **Automatic non discretionary deemed renewal of license through online system**, without the requirement of filing of application for renewal, subject to payment of fee prescribed by the Government from time to time, within the time prescribed, until further orders.
